

## Native Perennial Groundcovers

### Wild Ginger *Asarum canadense*

8" tall  
Prefers moderately moist rich soil  
Full sun or partial shade  
Inconspicuous maroon flowers in April-May



### Labrador (Alpine) Violet *Viola labradorica*

8" tall  
Prefers moist, well-drained soil  
Full to partial shade  
Lavender-blue flower in May  
Self-sowing



### Virginia Creeper *Parthenocissus quinquefolia*

30-50- tall vine  
Tolerant of most soil conditions  
Full sun to full shade  
Needs no support, fast growth rate  
Bluish berries ripen in September  
Attract birds  
Salt tolerant



### Red Bearberry *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*

Small trailing evergreen  
7" tall  
Prefers sandy or rocky soil  
Full sun to partial shade  
Pinkish-white flowers in May  
Red berries in fall attract ground dwelling birds  
Slow growing
